General Information: The general accounting scholarships are awarded to students who are in their junior year or later in one of the accounting majors. The scholarships are awarded twice per year, fall semester and spring semester. Funds for the fall awards are provided primarily by individual donors. In the spring, funds are provided primarily by accounting recruiters along with funds from individuals.

Eligibility and Application Deadline: To be eligible for the general accounting scholarships, a student must be accepted in an accounting major and have completed two of the following three courses: Acct. 301 - Intermediate I, Acct. 302 - Intermediate II, and Acct. 320 - Accounting for Production. Application deadlines are announced at the beginning of each semester.
